1.

Made defendants herein are:

- A. **Barrett L. Browning**, ("Browning") a natural person of the full age of majority that can be served at 1125 Lakemont Dr., Baton Rouge, LA 70816; and,
- B. Safeco Insurance Company of America, ("Safeco") a foreign insurer conducting business in Louisiana that can be served through the Louisiana Secretary of State at 8585 Archives Avenue, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70809,

who are justly and truly indebted unto the plaintiff for the following:

2.

Plaintiff is responsible for the administration, construction, improvement, maintenance, and repair of public transportation systems, traffic control devices, bridges, overpasses traffic barriers and guardrails under La. R. S. 48:11, and 36:501 et seq.

3.

Plaintiff is entitled to file and prosecute this suit without the payment of court costs in advance or as the same accrue under La. RS. 13:4521.

4.

Plaintiff owns a guardrail that was damaged in a single vehicle accident on December 30, 2022, while Browning was operating a 2010, GMC Yukon, VIN #:1GKUCCE00AR276067 on Interstate 10 in East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana.

5.

The accident and resulting damages were caused by the sole fault of Browning which

included:

- a) failing to keep a proper lookout;
- b) failing to keep proper control of said motor vehicle
- c) failing to take the proper evasive action to avoid the resulting collision;
- d) failing to maintain the vehicle as required for safe operation;
- e) failing to slow or stop the motor vehicle in time to avoid the resulting collision;
- f) operating the motor vehicle in a careless manner; and,
- g) all other acts and omissions shown at the trial of this matter.

**6.** 

Browning was insured under a policy of liability insurance issued by Safeco, Policy Number F3268244, that provides coverage for plaintiff's damages.

7.

Venue is proper under Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure article 42(7), La. R. S. 13:3203 & 22:1269(B) (1).

8.

Satisfactory proof of loss was provided to Safeco on August 17, 2023.

9.

Safeco has not initiated loss adjustment or made an offer to settle this claim, under La. R. S. 22:1892.

WHEREFORE, The State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation and Development prays that after due proceedings are had, for entry of the judgment in its favor and against defendants, Barrett L. Browning and Safeco Insurance Company of America finding them jointly and solidarily liable unto the Plaintiff for all damages allowed by law.

Plaintiff further prays for all other relief that is appropriate under the premises considered.
