LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT TRUCK PERMITS

Louisiana requires that a certificate of insurance, which insures any damage to state property, must be posted at the Truck Permit Office before any Oversize/Overweight Permit will be issued. The amount of coverage required is a minimum of \$100,000.

The Acord certificate should show the Louisiana Customer Account Number, effective date, expiration date as well as the amount of property damage coverage and the insurance contact information (name and phone number).

Escort vehicles must have general liability insurance, motor vehicle liability insurance, and workers' compensation, each providing for a minimum of \$500,000.00 in coverage (revised statute 387.1 [b]). At this time the Truck Permit Office is not requiring proof of workers' compensation until further notice.
