1. The current state tax is $\$ 0.16$ cents/gallon. Assuming a person drives 1000 miles per month, Gas cost is $\$ 2.27 /$ gal. the average total tax paid per vehicle is $\$ 134.00$ in a year. This excludes the $\$ 0.04$ cents as it is greater than $100 \%$ dedicated to debt service.
2. Cost per season ticket on the side line, at terrace 3.

- 16 states have gone two decades or more without a gas tax increase.
- 5 states have not seen an increase in their gas tax rate since the 1980's or earlier: Alaska, Oklahoma, Mississippi, South Carolina, and Tennessee.


## A real world model

> In 1989, a one-day pass at Disneyworld was \$29.

$>$ The state gas tax was 16 cents per gallon.
$>$ Today, a one-day pass a Disneyworld is $\$ 85$.

- A 193\% increase.
- Increase in prices have exceeded inflation and provided for expansion
$>$ Today, the state gas tax is still 16 cents.
- That's a 56\% decrease considering inflation.
