Trucking Drives the Economy

▼ Employment

- ▼ Wages exceed \$4.1 billion Average Salary: \$45,449
- ▼ 5,460 LA trucking companies small, locally-owned
- ▼ 78% of communities depend exclusively on trucks

▼ Highway Funding

- ▼ \$481 million in federal/state road taxes and fees
- ▼ 38% of all taxes/fees paid by Louisiana motorists
- 14% of vehicle miles traveled in the state
- One typical semi truck*

^{*}Does not include general business taxes/fees





Highway Safety

▼ Highway Safety

- ▼ 1.23 fatal crashes per 100 million VMT
- ▼ Rate dropped 73% since 1975
- ▼ Industry Invests at least \$9.5 billion annually
 - ▼ Education and Training
 - ▼ Compliance with Regulations Mandated
 - Driving Records, Drug Testing, Medical, Haz-Mat, Staff, Consultants, Compliance Technology
 - ▼ On-Board Technology
 - ▼ Electronic Logging (Mandate), Collision Avoidance, Stability Control, Cameras
 - Incentive Pay, Bonuses, Awards, etc.
