Instructions on How to Apply for DOTD Technician Certification

DOTD offers certification in the following areas:

- Embankment and Base Course
- Asphaltic Concrete Plant
- Asphaltic Concrete Paving
- PCC Paving
- Structural Concrete
- ◆ PCC Technician

Certification requires that the individual successfully complete four requirements:

- Course completions in the certification area.
- A written specialty area test in certification area.
- Performance evaluations in the certification area.
- Verifiable six months experience in the certification area.

To Apply for Certification:

Applications for certification are processed through the DOTD Construction and Materials Training Program Office.

1. Fill out a Nondepartmental Initial Certification form (Available from DOTD District Training Offices). This form must be signed by a supervisor.

The Test District is the District Training Office (see locations below) most convenient for you to travel to for testing. All testing will be arranged through this office.

- 2. Attach applicable fee payable by check or money order to LADOTD.
 - o Certified Technician: \$800.00 per certification area
 - City or Parish Employee \$100.00 per certification area
 - Authorized Concrete Field Tester \$120.00
- 3. Have the form reviewed and signed by a District Training Specialist before sending.

The application and payment are processed and a receipt for payment is sent to the company, governmental entity, or individual paying for the certification.

- 5. Go to the Test District Training Office to receive training materials and instructions for completing the certification program. The fee covers all training materials and testing.
