## **ATTACHMENT A**

## ROADSIDE VEGETATION MAINTENANCE STANDARDS

The following characteristics meet the desired maintenance conditions when:

Vegetation around structures 85% of structures are not obstructed

Waterborne & Exotic/Nuisance

Vegetation Ditch areas, retention and detention ponds are 75% free of

Undesirable vegetation

Roadside Mowing Turf height shall be kept between 5" and 18". Not more

than 1% of vegetation exceeds 18" inches high. This excludes allowable seed stalks and decorative flowers allowed to remain for aesthetics. Mower decks shall be set at 5". Herbicide applications to control growth will be allowed. No excessive brownout will be allowed, except on

invasive weed species.

Rural Limited Access – 5" – 18"

Urban Limited Access − 5" − 12"

Slope Mowing Not more than 2% of vegetation exceeds 18" in height.

This excludes allowable seed stalks and decorative flowers

allowed to remain for aesthetics. The area shall be

evaluated in accordance with the mowing.

Litter Removal The volume of litter does not exceed 3 cubic feet per 1 acre

excluding all travel way pavement. When performed concurrently with the mowing operation, the contractor shall pick up and properly dispose of all trash and debris ahead of the mowing operation. Trash and debris picked up and piled or bagged on the roadside must be removed by the contractor from the right of way by the close of business the same work day. Bagged trash and debris shall

not be piled on travel lanes or paved shoulders.

Turf in the movable areas is 75% free of undesirable

vegetation. Non-mowable areas within the right-of-way are

60% free of undesirable vegetation.

Invasive/Noxious Weeds Invasive/Noxious Weeds shall be controlled by herbicide

applications. Invasive/Noxious Weeds shall not cover

more than 25% of the total right-of-way per acre.

Compliance with all State and Federal regulations shall be

met at all times.

in or over travel way or clear zone, lower than 14 ½ feet or

lower than 10 feet over sidewalks. There shall be no

vegetation that violates the horizontal clearance as defined

by this standard.

Landscape and Wildflower Areas Vegetation is maintained in a healthy, attractive condition.
