- Main span update = update to main span type based on our field survey; if original span type
 was correct this is copied into this field (Field is within the CombinedMastNBI_All table, field
 name MAINSPAN_TYPE_UPDATE)
- Approach span update
- SHPO No. = inventory number assigned by the LA SHPO for eligible bridges
- Latitude and longitude update fields
- Preservation Category
- Designer/builder

Stipulation IX (6) Funding. LADOTD has let projects on LADOTD owned Preservation Priority Bridges involving preventive maintenance, preservation, and rehabilitation. LADOTD has exceeded the dedicated \$3 million annually to the preventative maintenance, preservation, and rehabilitation on preservation priority bridges. The following funding was authorized for construction on the Preservation Priority bridges in the table below in 2016-2017.

Recognition: On April 21, 2017, Walter C. Waidelich, Jr., Acting Deputy Administrator of the FHWA notified LADOTD Environmental Administrator Noel Ardoin and Mead and Hunt, Inc., Environment and Infrastructure Group Leader that LADOTD, FHWA Louisiana Division, the Louisiana State Historic Preservation Office, the Advisory Council on Historic preservation and Mead and Hunt, Inc., had won an Environmental Excellence Award for Excellence in Programmatic Agreements for the Louisiana Historic Bridge Inventory and Programmatic Agreement. The award is to be presented to LADOTD at the 2017 American Association of Highway and Transportation Officials Joint Sub-Committees on Design and the Environment meeting in Des Moines, Iowa on July 19, 2017.

These biennial awards honor outstanding initiatives and partnerships across the United States that incorporate environmental stewardship into the planning and project development processes using FHWA funding sources. FHWA wished to recognize and thank the awardees for commitment to environmental stewardship. FHWA stated that selection process was extremely difficult because of the high caliber of nominations and receipt of this competitive award is a real achievement.

The Louisiana Historic Bridge Inventory and Programmatic Agreement was a collaboration among the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD), Louisiana State Historic Preservation Office, Federal Highway Administration-Louisiana Division, Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, Mead & Hunt, and other agencies and organizations. The Historic Bridge Inventory involved evaluation of more than 4,500 State and locally owned bridges constructed through 1970 for National Register of Historic Places eligibility. By proactively identifying 150 historic bridges, the LADOTD can now consider these structures early in project planning and rehabilitate the best candidates for preservation. This accelerated project delivery process reduces the timeline for projects that involve any of the identified historic bridges. The capstone of the program is a programmatic agreement that outlines procedures for managing the historic bridges and provides for public outreach, training, and funding to support program execution.

Section 6. Emergency Situations for Historic Bridges

There were no emergency situations involving PA bridges in the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

Section 7. Recommendations for Improvements/Scheduling Changes/Problems Encountered/Disputes

Amendment to PA Stipulation VIII.B.5. Due to August 2016 flooding, which delayed review time for Groups 3 and 4 Preservation Priority bridges management plans, an amendment to the PA was executed to allow for adequate review time by PA Signatories. Stipulation VIII.B.5 was amended to read, "Plans will be completed within 24 months of PA execution. The LADOTD will submit draft plans to the Signatory Parties for 30-day review and comment. The LADOTD will finalize the plans taking any comments into account." The amendment was executed June 8, 2017.
