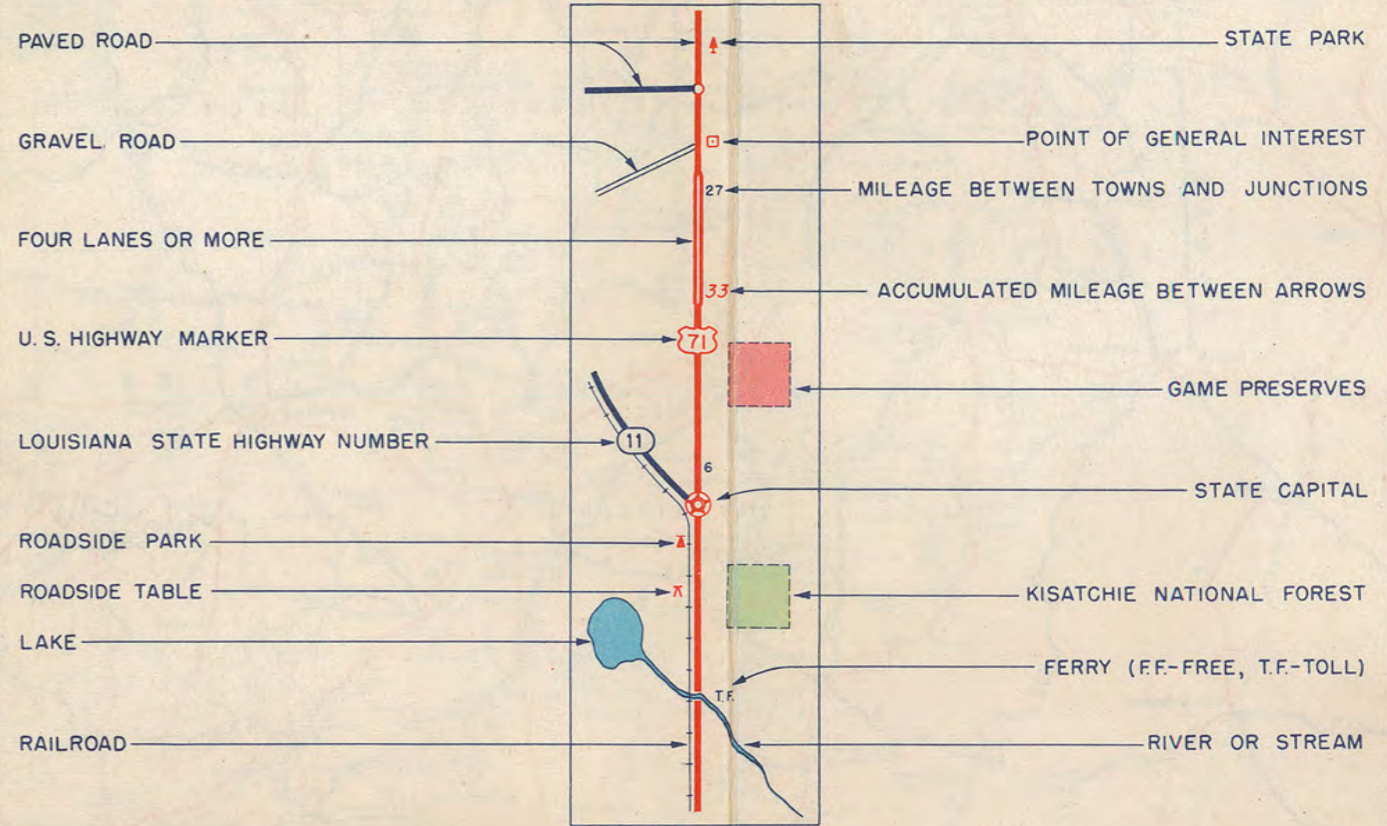


# TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC

- 100,000 AND OVER

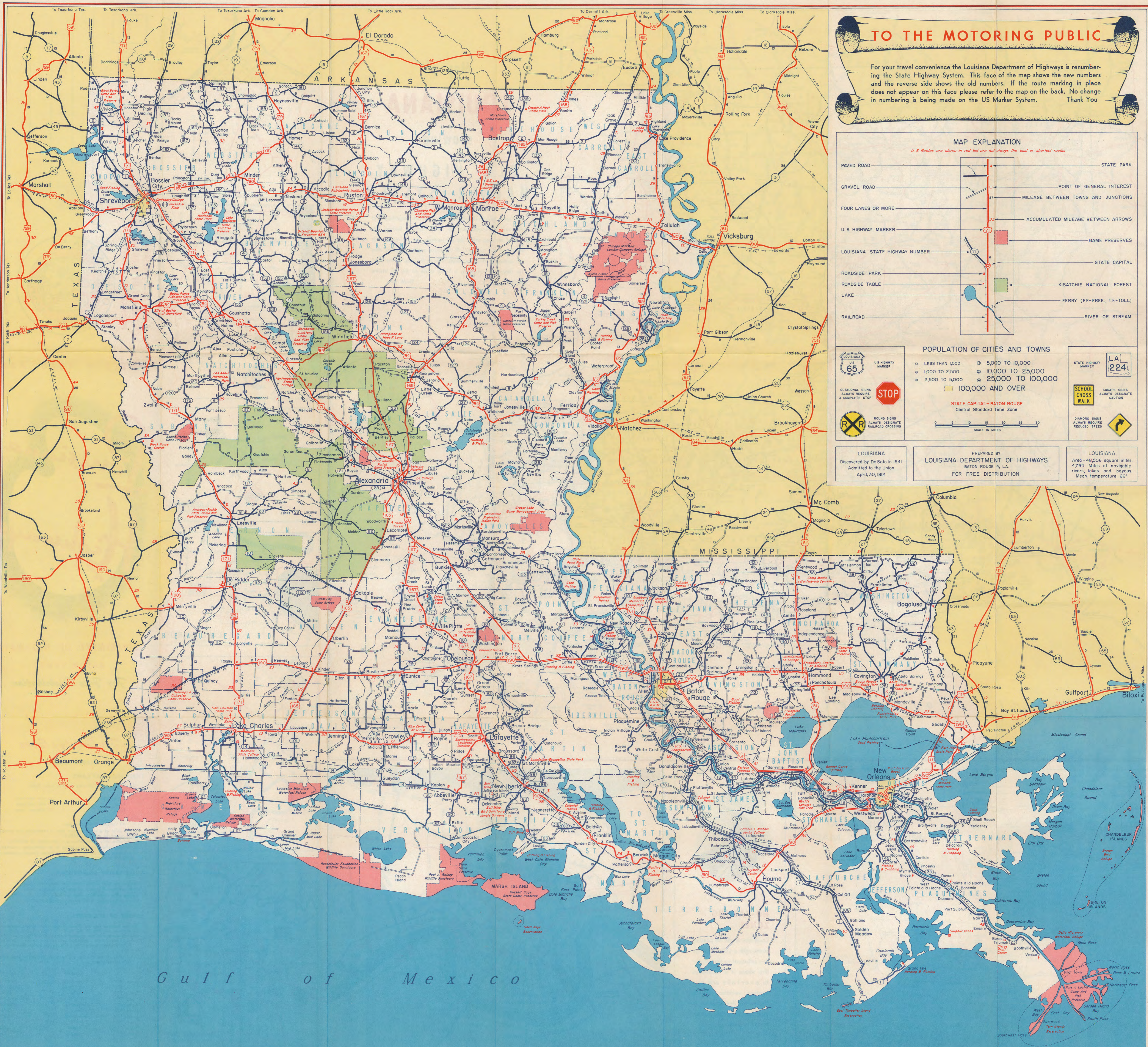
STATE CAPITAL - BATON ROUGE
