Please accept the most recently amended Transit Element of the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Planning Organization's FY 2019 – FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The changes below were approved by the Capital Region MPO Policy Committee on March 10, 2021.

FY 2021 – FTA 5307

- Removing \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) FY 2021 5307 funding from Associated Transit Enhancements – eliminating the Associated Transit Enhancements line item.
- Increasing Operating Assistance from \$1,176,000 federal (\$1,470,000 total) in FY 2021 5307 funding to \$1,184,000 federal (\$2,386,000 total).
- Changing the description of Rolling Stock in FY 2021 5307 funding from 'Up to 3 transit buses with power plants' to 'Up to 4 transit buses'.
- Decreasing Transit Vehicle Rolling Stock from \$172,000 federal (\$202,000 total) in FY 2021 5339 funding to \$119,000 federal (\$140,000 total).

Please also see attached the FY 2019-2022 Transit TIP projects, which will replace the previous version in its entirety. The new amendments will support the regional TAM targets set by CRPC (MPO) in coordination with LADOTD and CATS. The percent of revenue vehicles and equipment that have met or exceeded their useful life will decrease there by making the operations more efficient. Timely processing by your office will be, as always, greatly appreciated. Please contact me if you have any questions or need additional information.


